

## About ICAR-NRC on Yak

This ICAR institute was established in the year 1989 with its headquarter at Dirang (1500 m above msl), a small hill station in the West Kameng district of Arunachal Pradesh with a vision of Conservation and improvement of yak for higher productivity and profitability through innovative research. The experimental yak farm of the institute is located at Nykmadung (2750 m above msl) at a distance of 31 km away from Dirang.

Dirang is a small beautiful hill station with tourist round the year. The places to visit are the Regional Apple Nursery, Orchid centre at Jyotinagar, Thupsung Dargyeling Monastery, Dirang Dzong (Fort) and numerous picturesque spots with Kiwi in Sangti valley and Apple gardens at Zimithung around the valley. The weather of Dirang is pleasant throughout the seasons.

## Background

To cater to the needs of an organization, trained competent manpower are required to keep pace with the fast changing modern scenario. This programme is aimed to provide insights in diverse fields of allied agriculture and also to provide hands on training on various aspects on intellectual/material process and product development. The training has been designed to encourage adoption of management and

scientific skill for better output and to increase the competency in the trainees.
